UNIFORM CODE : PREPARATORY SCHOOL

Should a learner wish to be enrolled at Kingfisher Private School they must abide by the following rules at all times, regardless of religious, cultural or ethnic customs.

The following will apply during school time as well as after school as long as the learner is wearing his/her school uniform. The following is also applicable at school events.

A) Jewellery

- 1) **Earrings** : Only one pair of visible pierced earrings may be worn by girls in the lower ear lobe (one in each lobe), girls are allowed to wear plain gold or silver studs. (No sleepers, hoops, dangling or bulky/large earrings.)
- 2) **Bracelets** : Medic alert and mosquito deterrents may be worn. Watches may be worn.
- 3) **The following may not be worn :**
 - a) Rings
 - b) Necklaces
 - c) Brooches
 - d) Ankle chains
 - e) Body accessories, e.g. nose rings, tattoos, etc.
 - f) Hats or caps in the classroom

B) Hair

- a) Hair must be neat and tidy.
- b) For the girls: Hair that touches the collar of the shirt, or hair that falls forward must be tied back.
- c) Boys hair must be clean cut for at least 3 cm above the collar.
- d) Boys hair must be neatly clipped around the ears.
- e) Boys hair must slope evenly upwards with no visible step.
- f) The length of the longest part of Boys hair must not exceed 2.5 cm.
- g) Hair may not point away from the head in a permed or gelled style.
- h) No highlights or dyeing of hair is permitted.
- i) Boys faces must be cleanly shaven and their sideburns are not allowed to be lower than the centre of the ear.
- j) No dreadlocks.
- k) No wigs.
- l) All hair accessories must be blue or black.
- m) Girls are allowed to wear braids, which must be tied up if they touch the collar of the shirt.
- n) Girls who have coloured, relaxed or braided hair may not use this as an excuse not to swim.

C) Make-up

Make-up may not be worn by pupils.

D) Nails

- a) Nails are to be kept short and neat.
- b) No nail varnish allowed.

E) Underwear

The appropriate white or flesh coloured underwear to be worn.

F) **“Civvy Days”**
Non-revealing appropriate clothing to be worn.

G) **Clothing**

a) Only the School Uniform as set out by Kingfisher Private School is permitted.

- b) The Sports Uniform is to be worn at all sporting events and during Sports Activity periods.
- c) On a **Monday and Friday** the formal school uniform is to be worn.
- d) From **Tuesday to Thursday**, the PT uniform is to be worn to school for the activity period and then learners must change into their formal school uniform. Please ensure that your child brings the formal school uniform to school on these days.

SPORTS UNIFORM

Boys & Girls	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School Golf shirt • School Board shorts • White sport socks • Predominantly white trackshoes / takkies • Blue caps/hats may be worn. • Swimming: Girls: Navy Blue or black full swimming costumes only. No revealing swimwear allowed. Boys: Navy Blue or black speedo (long or short). Blue or black boardshorts may be worn for practice sessions <u>ONLY</u>.

H) **Provincial Tracksuit Policy**
 If a learner has earned Provincial Colours in any sporting code, they are entitled to wear their full Provincial tracksuit or blazer on Fridays only, with their normal school uniform.
